NOTICE OF HEARING
January 29, 2018

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to all interested persons within Burnet County, Texas:

That the Board of Directors of the Central Texas Groundwater Conservation District (CTGCD) will hold a public hearing, accept public comment, and may take action on the adoption of proposed amendments to CTGCD's Rules regulating water wells in Burnet County, Texas. The proposed rules amendments may adopt changes to the definition of Contiguous Controlled Acre. Changes may be made to the proposed amendments to the CTGCD's Rules based upon comments received or made at the hearing, and the amendments may be adopted with or without such changes without further notice or hearing.

This rulemaking hearing will be held on Monday, January 29, 2018, beginning at 9:00 a.m. at the District Offices, located at 225 S. Pierce, Burnet, Texas.

Any person who desires to appear at the hearing and present comment or other information on the proposed amendments to the CTGCD's Rules may do so in person, by counsel, or both. Comments may be presented verbally or in written form. Limits may be placed on the amount of time that each person is allowed to present verbal comments. The hearing posted in this notice may be recessed from day to day or continued where appropriate.
