The entrance to the Texas Agrilife Extension Auditorium will be the single glass door located on the south side of the building closest to the parking lot.

The following applicants are noticed to appear before the Board and required to show cause why a suit should not be initiated against the person in a court of competent jurisdiction for failure to comply with the orders or Rules of the Board, the relevant statutes of the State, or failure to abide by the terms and provisions of a permit issued by the District or the operating authority of the District.


