NOTICE: the General Manager of the District has determined the following permittees and well owner are non-compliant with the Districts’ rules and/or have violated the terms and conditions of their operating permit and the Board of Directors (“Board”) has directed that a hearing on each non-compliant permittees and well owner be held on Monday, July 19, 2021, at 9:00 a.m. at the District Office, 225 S. Pierce Street, Suite 104, Burnet, TX 78611, in accordance with the District’s rules.

The following permittees and well owner are noticed to appear before the Board and required to show cause why a suit should not be initiated against the person in a court of competent jurisdiction for failure to comply with the orders of the Board or Rules of the District, the relevant statutes of the State, or failure to abide by the terms and provisions of a permit issued by the District or the operating authority of the District.
